

# BOARD OF REVIEW(BOR) PROCESS

## TROOP 230

- *After a Scout has completed the requirements for any rank or Eagle Palm, he appears before a board of review. Its purpose is to determine the quality of his experience and decide whether he has fulfilled the requirements for the rank. If so, the board not only approves his advancement or Palm but also encourages him to continue the quest for the next rank or Palm.*
- *The board is comprised of no fewer than 3 Committee members.*
- *The Scout's parents, relatives, or guardians should not be in attendance in any capacity—not as members of the board, as observers, or even as the unit leader.*

# How to sign up for BOR

- ⦿ Scout should have all of his rank requirements signed off.
- ⦿ Approach the scribe window to put your name on the sign-up list.
- ⦿ **NOTE**: Collect your activity list Report and BOR Sheet from the scribe – when you sign up!
- ⦿ Keep the activity list and BOR sheet with you all the times. If you don't have these sheets, then your name goes to the bottom of the list

# FAQ

- ◉ **I signed up on the list, but my name keeps going to bottom of list. Why?**
- ◉ Discuss this with troop Scribe. He can provide more details on what is happening and what needs to be done to rectify it.
  
- ◉ **Can I sign up/schedule for a particular date?**
- ◉ No. This is not possible as the scouts are called for their BOR based on priority of their name on the list.
  
- ◉ **What are the minimum requirements to have a successful BOR?**
- ◉ There is not a definitive list, but below are some minimum requirements:
  - Ensure Troopmaster records is accurate - as regards to your Campouts, Service Hours, merit badges, and ranks. If not accurate, coordinate with Mrs Kerstetter to understand what needs to be done- before BOR.
  - Ensure Rank pre-requisites, Participation, ScoutMaster Conference, Service hours are all signed off in Scout Book – before you sign up on the BOR list
  - **Be Active in the Troop!** - 50% attendance over the year – troop meetings, leadership meetings & campouts to demonstrate scout spirit
  - Collect your Activity report and BOR report from scribe & keep on you at all times. If you don't have these reports when your name is called, you lose your turn for BOR. This is solely scout's responsibility.
  
- ◉ **When are BORs conducted?**
- ◉ During advancement nights (ONCE A MONTH) only.
- ◉ On exception basis, during Monday troop meetings and during a campout if there are 3 Committee members present.
  
- ◉ **What happens after BOR is completed?**
- ◉ If you are approved for the Rank, collect your rank patch from the Scribe. Card will be awarded at Court of Honor
- ◉ If you are denied for the Rank, work on addressing the requisites recommended by the Committee
